6 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS
7 FOLLOWS:

9 **WHEREAS**, the Political Reform Act requires the City Council, as the code
10 review body, to conduct a biennial review of the City's Conflict of Interest
11 Code, and

12 **WHEREAS**, the City Manager has provided proper notice to the City
13 Council of said review and has recommended certain changes to the City's
14 Conflict of Interest Code, and

15 **WHEREAS**, the City has held any required public hearings upon proper
16 notice,

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, as follows:


18 1. Since the adoption of the new Conflict of Interest Code via
19 Resolution 05-137, November 28, 2005, and the biennial review Resolution 08-
20 72, June 9, 2008, the City has determined that the following employment
21 positions with the City of Auburn have been deleted: Community Development
22 Director, Engineering Division Manager, Administrative Manager, Director of
23 Public Works, Fire Chief, Police Chief, Police Captain, and City Engineer.

24 2. In addition, the City Council desires to further amend the Conflict
25 of Interest Code to include on Exhibit A thereto the positions of Police
26 Lieutenant, Planning and Public Works Director, Transit Manager, Oversight
27 Board to the Successor Agency, and Director of Public Safety, with disclosures


1 by occupants of those positions pursuant to category I described in Exhibit B.

3 3. The City Clerk shall file a statement with the Fair Political Practices
4 Commission that the City Conflict of Interest Code has been amended in the



APPENDIX "B"

CITY OF AUBURN CONFLICT OF INTEREST

DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

- Category 1: Investments, business positions in business entities, and sources of income, of the type which contract with the agency to supply materials, commodities, supplies, books, machinery, vehicles or equipment utilized by the agency.
- Category 2: Investments, business positions in business entities, and sources of income, which are contractors or subcontractors, engaged in the performance of work or services of the type utilized by the agency, including, but not limited to, insurance companies, carriers, holding companies, underwriters, agents or accounting firms.
- Category 3: Investments, business positions in business entities, and sources of income, which have filed claims against the agency.
- Category 4: Investments, business positions in business entities, and sources of income, from banks and savings and loans.
- Category 5: Investments, business positions in business entities, and sources of income which are of the type in which the authority is empowered to invest its funds.
- Category 6: All interests in real property located within the jurisdiction of the agency.
