

## *Is Your Property Historic?*

Contact the Community Development Department to find out if your home already has historic status. Community Development maintains the *Auburn Register of Historic Buildings and Places*, the official list of properties designated by the City Council as having special historic significance within the City of Auburn. They also have a partial listing of homes that have been identified as having potential historic value. Not all of the historic homes in Auburn have been designated or previously identified. You can research your home's history to determine if it has architectural or historical significance and qualify as historic in the City of Auburn. The City Council has approved guidelines for nominating buildings and places to the Auburn Register.



The City of Auburn acknowledges owners of properties that have been restored to historical standards or have been remodeled or built to reflect the surrounding historical environment. These properties in themselves may not have any historical significance but the effort by the property owner to be sensitive to the historical environment should be recognized.
