NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Auburn City Council will hold a public hearing to extend Urgency Ordinance No. 17-14 – U, repealing and replacing section 159.019 of the Auburn Municipal Code regarding marijuana regulation. The Urgency Ordinance will continue to prohibit marijuana cultivation, dispensaries, manufacture, and delivery (except when prohibited by state law); but, will allow for indoor personal cultivation of up to six plants subject to a permit issued by the City.

Extension of Urgency Ordinance. At its regular meeting of October 23, 2017, the City Council adopted interim urgency Ordinance No. 17-14– U, which repealed and replaced Section 159.019 of the Auburn Municipal Code regarding marijuana regulation. Under Government Code sections 36934, 36937, and 65858, the City Council is authorized to extend the Urgency Ordinance for ten months and fifteen days upon a four-fifths vote. Therefore, interim Urgency Ordinance No. 17-14 – U will be extended to **September 7, 2018**.

Environmental Determination: The City Council has determined this Ordinance is exempt from California Environmental Quality Act review pursuant to Title 14, Section 15061(b)(3) of the California Code of Regulations.

Administrative remedies must be exhausted prior to action being initiated in a court of law. In accordance with Government Code section 65009, if any person challenges the action of the City Council in court, said person may be limited to raising only those issues that were raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing.

The hearing is scheduled for **Monday, December 11, 2017 at 6:00 PM** in the City Council Chambers, 1225 Lincoln Way, Auburn, California.
