

RESOLUTION NO. 23-17

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN REVISING THE
AUBURN ARTS COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:

Section 2 of Resolution No. 15-16 is hereby rescinded and replaced as follows:

SECTION 2. Membership. The Auburn Arts Commission shall consist of 12 members who are knowledgeable in the arts and shall conform to the following categories:

- 2 members shall be professional artists;
 - 1 member shall be a member of a local arts organization;
 - 1 member shall be an architect;
 - 7 members shall be at-large; and
 - 1 member shall be a member representing the youth of Auburn, aged between 13 to 18 years of age, residing within the City of Auburn, or enrolled in a high-school level program (or equivalent) in Auburn ("Youth Representative").

The Council may adjust the commission size by minute order. A quorum shall consist of a majority of filled seats. The Chair shall rotate annually except for the Youth Representative which shall be prohibited from holding the Committee Chair position..

The Youth Representative shall submit an application as determined by the City Clerk, including, but not limited to, a parent or guardian's signature acknowledging and consenting to the Youth Representative's participation and that the Commission meetings are public and subject to the Brown Act.

Section 4 of Resolution No. 15-16 is hereby rescinded and replaced as follows:

SECTION 4. Term. Commissions shall be appointed for 4 years, except for the Youth Representative which shall have a term of one year.

All other provisions of Resolution No. 15-16 remain unchanged and in full force and effect.


